Adoption Statement
Skelmersdale Town Centre SPD & Masterplan

On 10th September 2008 West Lancashire District Council adopted this Supplementary Planning Document (SPD). The adopted SPD provides planning guidance on the regeneration of Skelmersdale Town Centre. The SPD forms the basis for decisions on land use planning affecting that area.

Copies of the adopted SPD are available for inspection at the West Lancashire District Council Offices, 52 Derby Street, Ormskirk, Lancashire and Customer Service Point, Skelmersdale, free of charge on Mondays to Fridays 9am to 5pm (4-45pm Fridays) and at public libraries West Lancashire District during their normal opening hours. Copies of the Supplementary Planning Document will be made available on request from the District Council for a reasonable charge.

A person aggrieved by the proposals who desires to question the validity on the ground that they are not within the relevant powers or any statutory requirement has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the proposals, may make an application for a Judicial Review to the High Court.
